

MAKING A BEQUEST TO CHARITY

With our low overhead and more than 200 volunteers, the Oshkosh Area Community Pantry is able to provide five pounds of food for every dollar donated. Ninety-five percent of your donation goes directly to help your neighbors in need. All donations stay in our community.

A charitable bequest is one of the easiest gifts to make. You can create a bequest of any dollar amount, gift specific property, or designate a percentage of your estate in your will or trust plan. If you wish to make a gift of your IRA or 401(k) plan, this can usually be done by filling out a beneficiary designation form provided by your plan administrator.

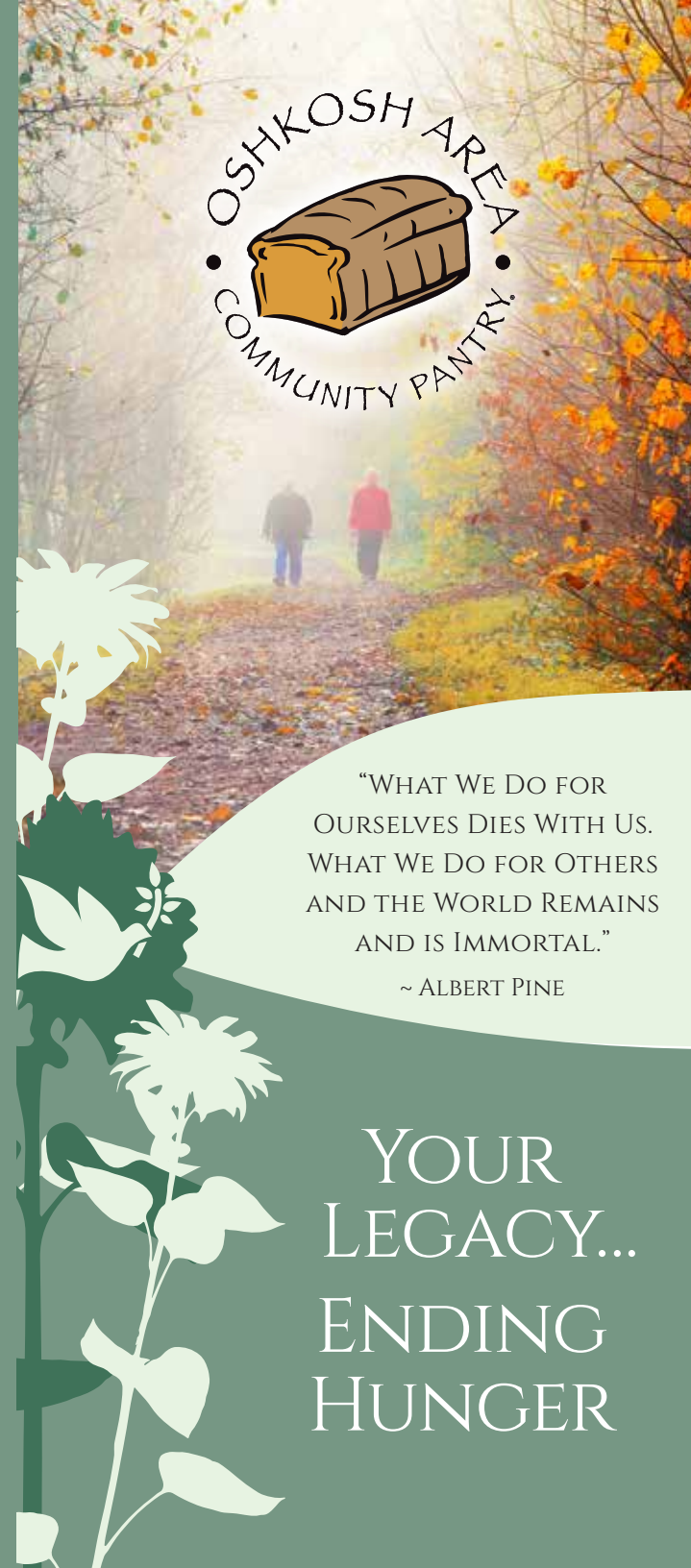

Make an unrestricted bequest to the OACP and your gift will be used where the need is greatest. The Oshkosh Area Community Pantry provides a range of beneficial programs and services, including:

- **Hunger Relief for Children**
Help us reduce child hunger by supporting our children's programming.
- **Healthy Food Options**
Help us make fresh produce available all year to our clients.
- **Support to Seniors**
Many of our clients are senior citizens with limited income and/or long-term health problems.
- **Home Delivery Services**
Support older and disabled clients who are no longer able to travel to the pantry for food.

FUTURE PLANNING OPTIONS

The wording of your bequest can be simple and direct: "I will and bequeath to the Oshkosh Area Community Pantry, Inc., located in Oshkosh, Wisconsin the sum of \$___ or ___% of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to be used for the general purpose of the Oshkosh Area Community Pantry, Inc. ID#26-3714702. There are other gift plan options available as well, such as the following:

- Life Insurance Policy Beneficiaries
- Will or Trust Provision
- Appreciated Stock
- Charitable Remainder Trust/Lead Trust
- Endowment Development

We are happy to work with your attorney or estate planner to draft language that ensures your wishes.
